KMITL would like to recruit qualified student for KMITL Doctoral Scholarships (Full scholarship) by Virtue of Announcement of the board of KMITL Research Fund and the board of KMITL Human Resource Fund in the title of KMITL Doctoral Scholarships.

1. KMITL Doctoral Scholarships

KMITL Doctoral Scholarships aims to produce highly qualified Ph.D. researchers of KMITL. The scholarships are provided for both Thai and International students within 3 consecutive academic years for a graduate of Master and 5 consecutive academic years for a graduate of Bachelor.

2. Qualification of the candidate

2.1 For a graduate of Bachelor, hold a bachelor's degree with a GPA of not less than 3.25 (from a total of 4.0)

2.2 For a graduate of Master, hold a bachelor's degree with a GPA of not less than 3.0 (from a total of 4.0) AND hold a master's degree in a discipline related to the proposed doctoral study with a GPA of not less than 3.5 (from a total of 4.0) OR have research publication(s), Innovation, Patent, Pretty Patent or Award.

2.3 be fluent in written and verbal English

3. Admission Application

3.1 Admission Application Period is from now until

October 2nd – November 15th ,2018

4. The scholarship recipients have to submit all of the following documents.

4.1 KMITL Doctoral Scholarships Application Form with a photograph taken not more than 6 months prior to the deadline of application.

4.2 A certified copy of Bachelor Degree Transcript in case graduated in Bachelor Degree and copy of Bachelor Degree and Master Degree Transcript in case graduated in Master Degree.

4.3 A certified copy of Identification Card

4.4 A certified copy of passport

4.5 A letter of Recommendation for KMITL Doctoral Scholarships (if any)

4.6 A certified copy of English proficiency test result (if any)

5. Expense covered by the Scholarship

5.1 Tuition fees

5.2 Salary

(1) For a graduate of Bachelor

12,000 baht/month for Thai students but not exceeding 60 months

18,000 baht/month for International students but not exceeding 63 months

(2) For a graduate of Master

12,000 baht/month for Thai students but not exceeding 36 months

18,000 baht/month for International students but not exceeding 39 months

5.3 Short-term Overseas Research for Thai students (400,000 baht)

5.4 An economy class air ticket for International students

6. Announcement of successful student

A list of successful student will be published on December 14th, 2018 at the Human Resource Management Office 5th floor, President's Building and www.hr.kmitl.ac.th

7. Remaining Status

7.1 In case of the recipients receive other scholarship due to inappropriate reasons, the scholarship will be terminated.

7.2 be a KMITL staff for Research Assistant position

7.3 The recipients should be fully aware, eager, and willing to reap the academic and other activities.

7.4 The recipients must sign the contract within 30 days after date of announcement of successful student

7.5 The recipients must submit a progress report at the end of every semester in order to receive the next installment of funding.

8. Publication

8.1 The recipients have to publish the research or show that the same has been accepted in some international journal (Full Paper) indexed as Q1 or Q2 or Q3 in the Web of Science at least 1 publication or indexed as Q1 or Q2 by Scimago Journal Ranking (Student as a first author is a must and with co-advisor) or any other work piece such as patent product, innovation product, creativity design, or commercial or public model 1 piece (within 3 year for a graduate of Bachelor and within 2 year for a graduate of Master).

8.2 The form of acknowledgement must be in the following words: "This work was supported by King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang"

8.3 The scholarship providers and the scholars have mutual proprietary rights to any research results that comes out from the project.

8.4 The research's benefit distribution must be in accordance with the institute's regulations.

8.5 In case of the scholars and the advisors cannot succeed the project's target without valid reasons, the scholars and the advisors will be no longer obtained any further institute's scholarships.

9. The scholarship will be terminated in the following cases;

9.1 leave education, retire or been revoked as punishment from Ph.D. Student status.

9.2 breached KMITL policies and procedures, rules and/or regulations.

9.3 receive other scholarship instead.

9.4 failed to meet the eligibility criteria and terms and conditions of your scholarship.

9.5 The recipients will not be able to complete their course within the standard years required.

9.6 Any decisions regarding changes to the agreements and regulations that may be made by the KMITL Doctoral Scholarships's committee.


